Insect Control in the Home

Wood-destroying insects and other organisms can cause serious problems in the wooden structural components of a house, and may go undetected for a long time. Control measures include reducing the potential infestation, preventing insect entry, and applying chemicals for remedial treatment.

Termites

Subterranean termites are the most damaging insects to wood. Their presence is hard to notice, and damage usually is found before the termites are seen.

Generally, the first sign of an infestation is the presence of swarming termites on the window or near an indoor light. Other signs include termite wings found on window sills or in cobwebs. Termites build shelter tubes, which are tunnels constructed so that they can travel from the ground to the wooden structural elements of the home. Usually, wood damage is not found at first, but if it is found, it is evidence of a past or active termite infestation and may require professional treatment.

Ants

Ants are among the most prevalent pests in households, restaurants, hospitals, offices, warehouses, and virtually all buildings where food and water can be found. While mostly harmless to humans, ants—especially carpenter ants—can cause considerable building damage. Winged ants are often mistaken for winged termites, which also leave their nests to mate.
