

## Petro-Meter Promotes Leak-Guardian® to NACHI Membership

This automatic water shut-off system is designed to activate upon the early detection of water system leaks, thus preventing catastrophic and costly flooding events. Plumbing and heating suppliers, installers, building owners, and insurance companies should take note.

The system uses strategically placed sensor/transmitter units that upon detecting a minute accumulation of water, will broadcast a radio signal to the receiving unit of a motorized ball valve actuator assembly. This device in turn will turn off the water supply, effectively eliminating the potential for a major flooding event. An unlimited number of sensors can be placed throughout a building, preferably near secondary supply lines. By placing sensors near boilers, dishwashers, basins, etc., Leak-Guardian® will cover an entire water system acting as a secure “around-the-clock watchdog” of flood prevention.

Lastly, sensor/transmitters can operate at a range of up to 150 feet from the receiver unit. The receiver unit is typically installed eight feet from the automatic ball valve actuator, making for an effective monitoring distance of at least 158 feet.
