Conferral: the undersigned counsel has conferred with counsel for plaintiff (“InterNACHI”). InterNACHI believes that ASHI does not have standing to respond to the motion for default judgment. However, to the extent the court finds it does have such standing, InterNACHI does not oppose a 3-day extension through and including Friday, February 17, 2017.

1. InterNACHI filed its Motion for Default Judgment with Attorney Affidavit (“Motion”) on January 24, 2017.

2. Any response to the Motion is due today, February 14, 2017.

3. On November 8, 2016, the court granted ASHI Intervenor status, giving it standing to challenge the Motion.

4. ASHI plans to file a response to the Motion but requires a short 3-day extension in which to do so. ASHI’s counsel is currently handling a few other pressing business matters and needs the short 3-day extension in order to prepare a comprehensive response.

FOR THESE REASONS, the court should extend ASHI’s time to respond to the Motion through and including Friday, February 17, 2017, and grant ASHI all such further relief as is just, proper, or appropriate.
