ASHI WILL CEASE CLAIMS IT IS THE LARGEST ASSOCIATION OF HOME INSPECTORS

In what may mark the end of a longstanding dispute between InterNACHI and ASHI, ASHI has informed InterNACHI it will cease claiming that it is largest association of home inspectors.

The dispute between the two trade associations has simmered for several years. Earlier this year InterNACHI formally asked ASHI to cease claiming it is the largest association of home inspectors. In support of its requests, InterNACHI provided ASHI with affidavits and documents to show that InterNACHI is the largest association.

When ASHI failed to respond to InterNACHI's requests, InterNACHI filed a lawsuit against the Northern Colorado Chapter of ASHI alleging violations of Colorado's Deceptive Trade Practices Act. The suit claims the chapter was misleading consumers by referring to ASHI as the largest association of inspectors on its website.

On April 9, 2013, ASHI's attorney sent a letter to InterNACHI's General Counsel, Mark Cohen, stating in part, "ASHI is committed and will work to eliminate any public claim for itself, the chapters, or members who claim that ASHI is the largest non-profit home inspection organization."

Cohen said the letter from ASHI's attorney pleased him, and he hopes ASHI will work to eliminate claims by ASHI, its chapters, and its members that it is the largest association of home inspectors.
